Drawing Club

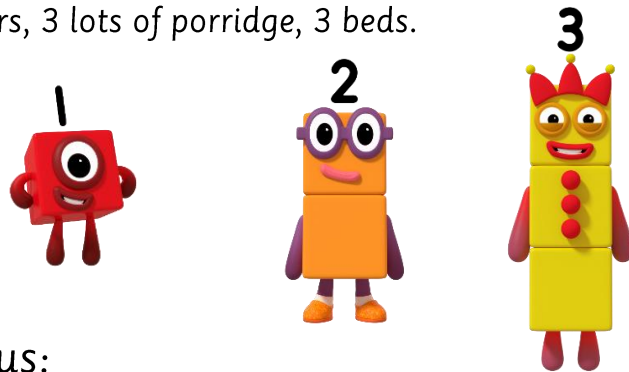
This week, we started Drawing Club and the children have absolutely loved it! We have been enjoying the story *The Colour Monster* and learning some fantastic new vocabulary, including *discombobulated*, *ineffectual*, *assist*, *shimmering*, *sobbing*, *enraged*, *evaporate*, *timid* and *tranquillity*. The children have learnt actions to go alongside these words to help bring the story to life and support their storytelling. I wonder if they can remember and tell you them.

The children have also drawn their own Colour Monsters (character) and designed houses for them (setting), complete with special magic codes. Ask your child to tell you about their Colour Monster, their house and their magic codes. We hope you love hearing all about the imaginative stories they came up with.

Maths

This week in maths, we have been learning all about the numbers 1, 2 and 3. We have been practising recognising these numbers, counting objects carefully and matching quantities to the correct numeral.

We have also been developing our **subitising** skills. Subitising is the ability to recognise a small number of objects instantly without needing to count them one by one. You could practise this at home by quickly showing your child up to 3 objects and seeing if they can tell you how many there are straight away or playing dice games. A good story is Goldilocks and the Three Bears - 3 bears, 3 lots of porridge, 3 beds.



Whole School Focus:

In assembly this week, Mr Gray has been talking to the children about cooperation, why we have rules, and how rules are there to help keep us safe. These important messages link closely to our school values and help children to develop positive relationships and make good choices.

We were also visited by TPAT Leads this week, who were incredibly impressed with how well the children have settled into their new routines, their enthusiasm for learning, and the way they engage with our continuous provision. We are very proud of them all.
